	Requirements and Expectations		
Major Assessment Task	Teacher sets due date for major assessment/assignment  Student does not meet submission date and has a valid reason the teacher grants an extension offer support		
non submittal support (MATSS)	Student that does not meet submission date, without a valid reason, is offered a Major Asst Task Support session (MATSS) and 10% less available marks
